What does enough look like?
What does enough sound like?
What does enough feel like?
How do we experience enough?
How do we know when we have enough?
Is there enough for all?

EXHIBITIONS

The first exhibition will be at The Statewide Gathering on December 9, 2010.
This second exhibition will be shown at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, 4100 Lyndale Avenue South, Minneapolis, MN on January 8-March 30.

JURORS

The Arts and Media Workgroup of AMWOP plus selected artists will serve as the jurors for the Arts Search.

ELIGIBILITY

This call is open to all visual/multi-media artists who live or work in Minnesota, working in any 2D, 3D and 4D media including painting, mixed-media, drawing,

printmaking, fiber, textiles, photography, sculpture, text, video, ceramics, film, graphics, sound, music, installation, performance. All works submitted must be available for the duration of the shows. Some projectors, monitors, and other technical equipment are available; please include in your submission which equipment you can provide or which you require. (See Submission Form for details. PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING AN ART ENTRY

Artists may submit up to 3 original works. All entries must be submitted in digital format via CD. Images should be in jpeg format only (no PowerPoint or Photoshop files) and at least 300 dpi not to exceed 6 inches on the longest side. Each image should be in the correct orientation and be labeled as follows: artistnameentry#.jpeg. For example, Jane Doe's first entry would be labeled janedoe#1.jpeg. The entry number on the photo should correspond to the entry number on the entry form.

If submitting performance, sound, multi-media, video etc, please include up to 10 minutes* on a DVD that is readable on a MAC or PC computer.

**If your performance artwork is selected you may be asked to condense the performance to fit a certain timeframe.*

Descriptions on the entry form and all images should accurately represent the work submitted. A Minnesota Without Poverty will reserve the right not to install selected work that substantially deviates from the description on the entry form and the images submitted.

Digital entries **must be received on or before midnight, April 29**. Notification of acceptance will be via e-mail. There is no entry fee.

Artists must submit a 100-200 word Artist Statement (hard copy and electronic copy) which addresses the relationship between the artist / the work and the ***In Search of Enough*** theme.

Artists must also complete and submit an Entry Form (Download available at www.mnwithoutpoverty.org)

Submit the following materials with each art entry:

- 1 CD including jpgs properly labeled
- 1 entry form
- 1 Artist Statement in hard copy
- 1 Artist Statement in electronic copy
